For manufacturing use only. BARQUAT MB-50W is a MANUFACTURING CONCENTRATE for formulating purposes only. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations.

This product should not be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such mixtures may be explosive. Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly after handling.

PRECAUTIONS:

FIRST-AID:
