DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

TREATMENT

DISPERSED PIGMENT PRESERVATION: AMA 415-C a Mineral Slurry Preservative is recommended for the control of bacteria and fungi in the manufacture and storage of dispersed pigments such as kaolin clay, titanium dioxide, calcium carbonate, calcium sulfate, barium sulfate, magnesium silicate, and Kieselguhr used in paint and paper productions.

Add 430 grams - 1.7 kg of AMA 415-C a Mineral Slurry Preservative to each 1,000 Kg of fluid to provide 425 to 1,675 ppm product (6.25 to 25 ppm isothiazolones).
