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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is to be used only in the manufacture of a microbiocide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

FIRST AID

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take Container, label, or Product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

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TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: There is no specific antidote. Medical personnel should provide symptomatic or supportive treatment. Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: Toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, or public waters. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: Containers should be stored in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep

The product can be stored at temperatures between -45°C and +50°C. To prevent contamination store this product away from food or feed.
