DIRECTIONS FOR USE: To be used only in the manufacture of a rodenticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash skin thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre of doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

For all cases of human ingestion, immediately notify a physician or poison control centre. If a pet or livestock poisoning is suspected, immediately contact a veterinarian. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION
