DIRECTIONS: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Hold can upright while spraying.

TO KILL HOUSE PESTS:

Flying Insects: Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, Gnats and Flying Moths.

Close doors and windows. Direct mist upwards in sweeping motion to all parts of the room especially windows and other light sources. Apply 6-10 seconds burst per 30m3 of space. Whenever possible, keep doors and windows closed for 15 minutes after each treatment. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Keep spray at least 1m from interior wall, fabrics and furniture. Ventilate well after use.

Crawling Insects:

Cockroaches, spiders, crickets, ants, carpet beetles, centipedes and silverfish. Spray hiding places such as baseboards, moist areas, openings around sinks, drains and pipes, behind cabinets and storage areas. Spray ant trails, around door sills, window frames, or in ant nests. Insects must be hit to be killed.

Moths:

Treat infested enclosures arranging clothing and other articles so that the mist can circulate freely. Close treated area for at least 45 minutes. Do not spray closer than 1 meter to fabric. Exceeding dosage rates and bi-weekly applications may cause stains on fabrics, furs and other materials.

Bed Bugs:

Spray mattress, particularly around seams and tufts. Take beds apart, spray all joints. Repeat as required.

Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks:

Spray infested areas such as pet's bed and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Remove old bedding and replace with fresh clean bedding after treatment. Insects must be contacted to be killed. Do not treat animals with this product.

TO KILL GARDEN PESTS ON FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS:

Sucking Insects: Exposed thrips, leaf-hoppers, spotted mites, lace bugs, aphids. **Chewing Insects:** Caterpillars, climbing cutworms, Japanese beetles. For insects on asters, azaleas, begonias, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, gladiolus, irises, marigolds, petunias, roses, snapdragons, evergreens, small deciduous trees, shrubs and vines. Carefully spray with slow sweeping motion keeping 30 cm to 45 cm away from the plants to avoid wetting the foliage. A light spray kills pests effectively. Spray only when air is still and temperature is under 32°C. Do not spray in direct sunlight. Early morning or evening is preferred. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not use in presence of open flame or spark. Do not puncture or incinerate container, or store at temperatures over 50°C. Cover fish bowls and remove pets for one hour when spraying rooms. In houses or dwellings, remove or cover all exposed foods and cooking utensils before spraying. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on Maiden Hair ferns. Do not use on vegetable or fruit crops.

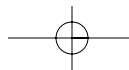
FIRST AID:

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL:

When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then dispose in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.

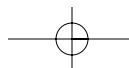
