DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Weight per **SpaGuard® Sanitizer Smart Tabs®** tablet: Approximately 20 g

WARNING: Direct **SpaGuard Sanitizer Smart Tabs** contact may cause bleaching. Automatic feeding devices employing **SpaGuard Sanitizer Smart Tabs** must be totally free from traces of other spa sanitizers to avoid the probability of an explosion.

1. Maintain recommended daily levels as determined by testing kit.

Free available chlorine: 3 - 5 ppm

pH: 7.2 - 7.8

Total Alkalinity: 100 - 120 ppm

Calcium Hardness: 200 - 300 ppm

2. Superchlorinate a freshly filled spa by following the manufacturer's instructions of the superchlorinator employed. Maintain water circulation at least 15 minutes before using. Repeat superchlorination procedure after each use period.

3. If using an automatic chlorinator, fill the chamber(s) with **SpaGuard Sanitizer Smart Tabs** and adjust flow rate, according to manufacturer's recommendations, to maintain proper chlorine residual. Adding **SpaGuard Sanitizer Smart Tabs** to the spa's skimmer basket is an alternative chlorine feed method. Daily usage should approximate 10 g of **SpaGuard Sanitizer Smart Tabs** per 1000 L of spa water.

NOTE: Hot weather, heavy spa usage, and use of spa bubblers may require higher usage rates to maintain proper chlorine residuals.

4. Periodic superchlorination of spa water is recommended. Follow label instructions of superchlorinating product being employed.

5. Persistent foam formation, turbid, or malodorous water are indicators of inadequate sanitizer levels. To correct such conditions, superchlorinate spa water by following the manufacturer's instructions of the superchlorinator employed. Maintain circulation at least 30 minutes and wait 4 hours before using. **SpaGuard Sanitizer Smart Tabs** contain a stabilizer (cyanuric acid) which will accumulate in spa water. Keep stabilizer within 30 - 100 ppm range by dilution with fresh water.

6. For proper sanitation, spa must be completely drained periodically. The number of days between COMPLETE SPA DRAINAGE is equal to the volume of spa water in litres, divided by 10 times the maximum number of daily spa users. Refill spa with water and repeat DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

7. Maximum spa water usage temperature is 40°C. Duration in spa water at 40°C should not exceed 15 minutes.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Dangerous gas formed when mixed with acid. Do not mix with any other chemical. Strong oxidizing agent. May

cause fire or explosion if contaminated. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. It is recommended to wear rubber gloves when handling this product. Harmful if swallowed. Keep container closed and store in a cool, dry location.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If in eyes,** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Do not reuse. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency on case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
