DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled.

Avoid inhalation of dust. May cause irritation of the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. During mixing and/or blending operations, wear a hat or other suitable head covering, a long-sleeved shirt and long-legged trousers or a coverall-type garment (all of closely woven fabric covering the body, including the arms and legs), shoes, socks and impervious (rubber or neoprene) gloves. FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
