ADAMA X-ACT is a liquid emulsifiable concentrate of oil and 30% phosphate ester surfactant that may be tank mixed with pest control products (refer to specific product label for directions).

ADAMA X-ACT + ARROW 240EC

ADAMA X-ACT maybe used in a tank-mix with the post-emergence herbicide Arrow 240 EC for control of grass weeds, volunteer cereals and quackgrass incanola, flax (including low linolenic acid varieties), field peas, lentils, Desi and Kabuli chickpeas, dry onions, potatoes, mustard (oriental, brown, yellow), soybeans, seedling alfalfa, sunflowers and dry beans (Pinto, Black, Great Northern, RED, Pink and Navy).

PRECAUTIONS:

WARNING: Causes skin and mucous membrane irritation. DO NOT get on skin. Severely irritating to the eyes. DO NOT get in eyes. Potential skin sensitizer.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Goggles, face shield and gloves should be worn when handling, mixing and loading. Wash concentrate from skin or eyes immediately. Avoid breathing vapours or spray mist. Avoid working in spray mist. After use, wash hands and other exposed skin thoroughly. Store the container tightly closed away from seeds, fertilizer, plants and foodstuffs. Avoid contamination of ponds, streams, rivers and other water sources. DO NOT APPLY BY AIR.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take the container label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: May be stored at any temperature.

DISPOSAL:

Recyclable Container Disposal: Do not reuse this container for any purpose. This is a recyclable container, and is to be disposed of at a container collection site. Contact your local distributor/dealer or municipality for the location of the nearest collection site.

Before taking the container to the collection site:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
2. Make the empty, rinsed container unsuitable for further use.

If there is no container collection site in your area, dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.

Disposal of Unused, Unwanted Product: For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
