### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water. Do not apply directly to water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not allow chips or dust, generated during paint removal, to enter water.

### FIRST AID

This product may produce temporary allergic side effects characterized by redness to the eyes, mild bronchial irritation and redness or rash to exposed skin areas. Persons having allergic reaction should contact a physician immediately.

### Left panel DIRECTIONS FOR USE FOR NYLON AQUACULTURE NETS ONLY

Flexgard VI ready for use. Materials treated with Flexgard VI Waterbase Preservative are intended for outdoor use only. An antifoulant, it protects against fungal growth, algae and marine fouling organisms on above-waterline and submerged Flexgard VI coated surfaces such as buoys, nylon fishnets and ropes.

1. The surface should be cleaned and dry before application.
2. Stir contents of container before each use.
3. Apply liberally by brush or dipping. Thoroughly cover cut ends and joints.

4. If applied by brush, use two (2) coats.
5. Repeat applications on textiles, such as nylon nets, cord, rope, or if when mildew appears.
6. If applied by dipping, allow article to remain in solution a minimum of 15 minutes.
7. Allow 6-8 hours drying time between coats.
8. Allow minimum of 72 hours air drying before use.
9. Clean tools, protective gloves and clothing with water when finished.
10. Do not apply at or below freezing temperatures.

#### **COVERAGE**

Estimated coverage for this product depends on application.

**DO NOT** apply this product in a way that will contact workers or bystanders, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

**DO NOT** contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**DO NOT** apply this product directly to freshwater habitats (such as lakes, rivers, sloughs, ponds, prairie potholes, creeks, marshes, streams, reservoirs and wetlands), or estuarine/marine habitats.

**DO NOT** discharge effluent containing this product or the biocide produced into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless the effluent has been detoxified by suitable means.

**DO NOT** place the painted parts in water after painting until the paint is fully cured (see recommended times on the label). It is recommended that you prevent paint chips or dust caused by removing paint from entering water.

#### **PRECAUTIONS**

**DO NOT** get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear long pants, a long-sleeved shirt and shoes plus socks during mixing/loading, application, clean-up and repair. In addition, wear chemical resistant gloves and footwear, and chemical resistant clothing with head covering, at all times during handling and applying.
