**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** In recirculating cooling and process applications, use at 100 ppm active ingredient based on water content of system until control is achieved. Maintenance dosage 10 -25 ppm.

**FIRST AID:** In case of contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. In case of contact with skin and clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. ### **DISPOSAL:**
