An Age-Old Problem

You've sprayed, baited traps, dusted powders, even resorted to dangerous poisons, but common household pests continue to plague your premises. In fact, they are probably thriving and multiplying.

The Ultrasonic Tool

Now there's a safe, effective addition to the pest control arsenal. It's ultrasound. Ultrasound consists of electronically generated ultrasonic sound waves, broadcast at a high volume. It can cause rodents to avoid a sound protected area. While the sound can't be heard by humans, domestic pets, farm animals, birds or fish, research proves it is irritating to rodents (including hamsters, gerbils, guinea pigs and rabbits), and can cause them to leave the transmitting area.

What is Ultrasound?

It is sound waves with frequencies too high to be heard by the human ear. The average person can hear sound waves ranging from 20 up to 20,000 cycles per second, while dogs perceive them up to 27,000 per second, and the range of other animals is even higher. When measured electronically, these frequencies are expressed in hertz, defined as a unit equal to one cycle per second. So ultrasonic sound waves are frequencies over 20 kilohertz.

Using Your PestChaser

Place the equipment on a table, shelf or mount on the wall. Best placement is 2 to 4 feet off the floor with the speaker grill aimed at known problem areas. In a kitchen, aim toward infested cupboards.

Ultrasonic sound is highly directional and will be reflected by hard surfaces to literally fill a room with the sound pressure.

Answers to Questions About Ultrasonic Pest Repelling Devices

Q. Which pests can they affect?

A. Mice and rats. NOTE: Pet rodents, such as hamsters, gerbils, guinea pigs, and rabbits will also be bothered in an ultrasonically protected area.

Q. Does ultrasonic sound kill pests?

A. No. It repels and/or creates an acoustically hostile environment. Tests on rats and mice show they move out of the acoustic range to get away from the noise. Some insects may exhibit avoidance behavior.

Q. How long will it take to work?

A. Allow two to eight weeks for ultrasonic sound waves to affect pests with an established food source. Once a pest problem is brought under control using ultrasound combined with other pest control methods, PestChaser can work as a continuing pest deterrent aid.

Q. Can ultrasound affects pests in walls?

A. No. Ultrasound is directional and can't penetrate anything solid. For problems with pests in walls or foundations, contact a professional pest control operator.

Q. Can I do away with pesticides and/or traps?

A. No. Ultrasound is one tool used in an integrated pest management program. It should be utilized in combination with other pest control methods. For example, poisons or traps can be placed outside an ultrasonically protected area; the sound pressure can help move pests toward the bait, resulting in a more rapid eradication.

Q. What coverage can I expect?

A. Quality equipment is capable of covering typical single rooms found in a family home. Most homes will require multiple units for best results. Obstacles, furniture and stored products in an area to be protected will affect coverage area.

Q. Where should units be placed?

A. PestChaser is best used in rooms where food is consumed, prepared or stored. Storage areas and paper products often attract rodent activity. Put on a shelf or table, or mount it on a wall. For best results, place two to four feet off the floor with the speakers aimed at known problem areas. Do not place the PestChaser on a floor or aim it directly at soft drapery as the sound will tend to be absorbed rather than reflected.

Impacts on:

Rats, mice and other rodent species.

(Do not keep rodent pets, gerbils, hamsters or guinea pigs in an ultrasonically protected area).

When used with other pest control methods, PestChaser can increase the overall effectiveness of your efforts to eradicate rodent infestations.
