DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Shake before using. Close doors, windows and other openings and remove all animals from buildings before application. Apply with a mist fogger (nonthermal) at a rate of 100 ml/100 m3. Wear mask or respirator and protective clothing. Direct spray, upwards towards ceiling and walls or straight on insects.
