DIRECTIONS:

- **1.** DO NOT apply when swimmers are in the immediate vicinity (a 15-minute restrictedentry interval is recommended).
- 2. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 200 mL of Guardex Algae Control 10 per 10,000 litres of pool water.
- **3.** Weekly maintenance dosage is 100 mL of **Guardex Algae Control 10** per 10,000 litres of pool water.
