PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

DANGER: CORROSIVE TO EYES - SKIN IRRITANT. Do not get on skin, in eyes or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Avoid inhalation of dust or spray mist. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Avoid alcohol.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds.

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, cleaning of equipment or disposal.

Do not reuse empty container.

FIRST AID:

If in contact with skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If ingested, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean up of spills.

DIRECTIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL USE:

Preservation of adhesives - To prevent bacterial degradation of dry starch and synthetic latex adhesive formulations (after water is added by end-user), add 0.185% to 0.5% **VANCIDE MZ-96 Technical** , by weight of total composition, during adhesive manufacture.
