DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This product is to be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations.

This product should **not** be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such mixtures may be explosive. Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly after handling.

PRECAUTIONS:

FIRST-AID:

Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
