PRECAUTIONS

DO NOT CONTAMINATE FEED OR FOOD. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN AND UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Causes eye irritation. May cause dermal sensitization. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe vapour. Wear a respirator, coveralls, hat, waterproof boots, chemical resistant gloves, goggles or safety glasses, and/or face shield. Wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before using.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: In case of poisoning, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Have patient lie down and keep quiet.

FIRST AID

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If eyes are contaminated:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Skin exposure may cause transient sensations (tingling, burning, itching, numbness). Other symptoms of exposure could include respiratory effects (such as cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath), nausea, dizziness. Treat symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS

TOXIC to aquatic organisms. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

STORAGE

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed. Store in original container and out of the reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area.

Handle an open container in a manner as to prevent spillage. If container is leaking, invert to prevent leakage. If the container is leaking or material is spilled for any reason or cause, carefully dam up spilled material to prevent runoff. Refer to Precautionary Statements on label for hazards associated with the handling of this material. Do not walk through spilled material. Absorb spilled material with absorbing type compounds. In spill or leak incidents, keep unauthorized people away.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture (formulating, repacking, repouring) of a pest control product solely

for export from Canada. CYLATHRIN Technical Insecticide is intended for formulation into end use products for: **Domestic Indoor and Outdoor Uses.**

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

Cylathrin Technical Insecticide is a synthetic pyrethroid (Group 3) insecticide. Any insect population may contain individuals naturally resistant to Cylathrin Technical Insecticide and other Group 3 insecticides. The resistant individuals can dominate the insect population if these insecticides are used repeatedly. These resistant insects will not be controlled by Cylathrin Technical Insecticide or other Group 3 insecticides.

To delay insecticide resistance, avoid the exclusive, repeated use of Cylathrin Technical Insecticide or other insecticides in the synthetic pyrethroid group. Integrate other control methods (chemical, biological, good sanitation practices) into insect control programs whenever practical. Keep accurate records of insecticides used in each location.

NOTICE TO USER: This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label.
