## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Cunapsol-5 is a concentrate and requires dilution with water before use. To treat wood, dilute one volume of Cunapsol-5 with 4 volumes of water.

For the preservation of exterior wood products. For exterior use only. Not for use in dwellings.

DO NOT apply using an airless sprayer. DO NOT apply this product to wood that will be used in water.

For above ground use only. Apply to the wood surface only by brush for on site field applications.

For industrial use only in commercial spraybox, flow coating or dip tank. Equipment must be free of leaks. Equipment must have provision to eliminate or contain mist, overspray, drips and spillage into the surrounding environment.

Use of this product in industrial settings requires adequate engineered ventilation and containment in the treating areas and in the area where wood is dried.

Do not use the preservative or treated wood where Copper Napthenate may contaminate food, feed or drinking water. May be used on greenhouse and garden timbers in contact with non-food producing plants only. Carrier solvent must be allowed to dry thoroughly before introducing plants to prevent phytotoxicity.

DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans and other waters.

DO NOT contaminate irritation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

## PRECAUTIONS

Causes skin and eye irritation. Potential skin sensitizer. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing concentrated vapour. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Wear a cartridge respirator when handling the concentrate and if the area is not well ventilated when handling the dilute solution. Respiratory protection should also be worn during cleaning, maintenance and repair activities on storage or treatment vessels.

Wear full-face protection (including protective eyewear), coveralls over a long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical-resistant gauntlet gloves, chemical-resistant apron and chemical-resistant boots when handling the concentrate or dilute solution and during cleaning, maintenance and repair activities. In addition, a respirator is required for workers applying copper products by brush.

Do not use or store near open flame or spark, or in areas subject to excessive heat.

## FIRST AID
