POOL BLOCKS non-foaming solid algicide kills green, mustard algae and black algae growing on the walls of swimming pools. It is not affected by sunlight and keeps water sparkling clear.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Initial dose – place one (1) POOL BLOCK per 25,000 litres of pool water in the weir skimmer basket when the pump is running.

If algae persists, a monthly maintenance dose of one (1) POOL BLOCK per 50,000 litres or half (1/2) per 25,000 litres is recommended.

Adjust pool water pH and maintain between 7.2 - 7.6 during treatment. Brush walls weekly when treating blackspot algae. Use in conjunction with chlorine or an approved bactericide when swimming.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PRECAUTIONS:

Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid inhaling dust. Wear gloves when using Pool Blocks Algicide. Do not mix with other chemicals or throw any undissolved chemicals including calcium based chlorine into the pool when using this product. This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent into lakes, rivers, ponds or public waters.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Dispose of empty container in household garbage. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

FIRST AID: If in contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
