NOTICE TO USER: This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the *Pest Control Products Act* to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label. The user assumes the risk to persons or property that arises from any such use of this product.

NATURE OF RESTRICTION: For use by authorized customers where the vendor maintains a record of sales, including the name and address of the purchaser, amount purchased together with a signed Notice to Purchaser Agreement.

RESTRICTED USES: This product is sold as, and intended for exclusive use as a bear repellent. Use of this product in a manner other than self-defense against bear attacks may constitute a criminal offence.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Upon purchase cut and remove white cable tie. When threatened by a bear, place forefinger through hole in handle. Place thumb in front of orange safety clip and remove it by lifting up and back. Point nozzle directly toward bear's eyes and nose. Depress actuator tab for a burst of spray to a maximum range of 4 meters. Move away to avoid exposure to spray. Replace orange safety clip after use.

TIMING OF APPLICATION: Capsaicin sprays have been proven effective in repelling bears approaching closely. Use only as a last resort. There is no guaranteed method of responding to a bear encounter, each case is unique.

USE LIMITATIONS: This product is not to be sold to anyone under 18 years of age.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Container may explode if heated. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not puncture container or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not use in the presence of spark or open flame. Avoid touching eyes and face until you have washed your hands. Severe irritation to nose, respiratory and skin areas can occur. Persons with respiratory problems or wearing contact lenses should not use this product. While travelling do not store in passenger compartment. Contact air carriers concerning air transport. This product is for spraying the face of aggressive bears only and is not to be used against domestic animals or human beings. Do not spray objects/areas for use as a repellent.

DISPOSAL: Do not incinerate. When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Dispose of empty container in accordance with the provincial requirements. For information and disposal of unused, unwanted product contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

FIRST AID: In case contact with eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. In case of skin or clothing contact, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
