43 Advantage 9 Flea Adulticide will control fleas on cats within one day of treatment and  
44 will continue to protect the cat from further flea infestation for up to four weeks.  
45 Reinfestation from the emergence of new fleas in the environment may continue to  
46 occur for six weeks or longer after treatment is initiated. Reapply every 4 weeks for  
47 continual pest control in situations where there is an on going risk of pest infestation.  
48 Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem reoccurs.

49  
50 Shampooing of the cat may shorten the duration of flea protection, therefore, re-  
51 application following shampooing is recommended.

52 For effective flea control, treatment of the pet should be combined with the sanitation of  
53 any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets and furniture (discard vacuum bag  
54 after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas. If pest  
55 problems persist an insecticidal premise treatment may be required.

57 For use on pregnant/lactating animals consult your veterinarian.

58 The successive feeding activity of fleas on pets may elicit a hypersensitivity skin  
59 disorder known as flea allergy dermatitis (FAD). Treatment of pets with Advantage 9  
60 Flea Adulticide rapidly kills fleas and may reduce the incidence of this condition.

61 Advantage 9 Flea Adulticide is safe to use concurrently with commonly used veterinary  
62 products. Consult your veterinarian before using on animals receiving drug treatment.

112 • Do NOT administer by mouth. Do NOT use on other animals. Consult a veterinarian  
113 before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or  
114 other pesticide treatment. A veterinarian should be consulted when pest infestation  
115 continues to be a problem on the pet.

116 • Treatment must only be repeated if the pest problem reoccurs.

117 • Do not use on cats under 8 weeks of age.

118 • Use only on cats weighing 4 kg and under.

119 • This product is packaged in single dosage tubes. This package contains 1 to 6  
120 monthly 0.4 ml dosages. Treat your cat monthly in the manner described below. Do  
121 not apply a dosage higher than one 0.4 ml tube at a time.

122 • Remove one applicator from the package.

123 • Hold applicator tube in upright position. Pull cap off tube.

124 • Turn cap around and place other end of cap back on tube.

- 125 • Twist cap to break seal, then remove cap from tube.
- 126 • Part the hair on the neck at the base of the skull until the skin is visible. Place the tip
- 127 of the tube on the skin and squeeze the tube to completely empty the contents
- 128 directly on the skin. Do not get this product in your pet's eyes or mouth. The product
- 129 is bitter tasting and salivation may occur for a short time if the cat licks the product
- 130 immediately after treatment. Treatment at the base of the skull will minimize the
- 131 opportunity for the cat to lick the product.
- 132 • Until Advantage 9 Flea Adulticide dries, keep pet off furniture and away from
- 133 hardwood floors. Discard the empty tube as described in "DISPOSAL".
