DISPOSAL: DO NOT reuse the empty container. Dispose in household garbage. Unused or partially used product should be disposed at provincially or municipally designated hazardous waste disposal sites.

STORAGE: To prevent contamination store this product away from food and feed.

GENERAL INFORMATION: Scent-a-gone[®] contains ingredients that irritate animals when they touch or taste the product. It can be used to repel animals such as dogs, cats, groundhogs, skunks and raccoons from treated areas for about 30 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

INDOORS: Spread at a rate of 83g/m² (about 100ml/m²) on areas to be protected. Reapply after 30 days if animals continue to be a problem. Treatment must only be treated if pest problem persists or reoccurs.

A 1 kg product will treat about 12 m². DO NOT apply to any indoor plants or where children will play.

OUTDOORS: Apply on sunny, dry days. Spread by hand (gloves are recommended) or using manual or motorized spreaders at a rate of about 117g/m² or about 125ml/m². May be applied to lawns, garden paths and flower beds. To protect particular sites, such as garbage bags, ornamental plants, trees or buildings (e.g., garages, verandas, sheds) apply on the ground as a protective band 0.5 m for skunks, 2 m for raccoons, 0.3 m for groundhogs, 0.5 m for dogs and 0.3 m for cats. A quantity of 100g will treat about 0.85 m². Reapply after 30 days if animals continue to be a problem. Treatment must only be treated if pest problem persists or reoccurs. DO NOT apply to any indoor plants or where children will play. DO NOT enter or allow entry into treated areas until dust has settled.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.
