DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

ROLL DRUM OR STIR WELL BEFORE USING

FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT is a liquid seed treatment for use on canola and mustard for c ontrol of damping off a nd root rot caused by *Rhizoctonia solani* and "seed borne" Blackleg and Alternaria Black spot on emerging seedlings.

Rate: 22.5 mL per kg of seed or 563 mL per 25 kg bag of see d. (The 100 L container treats 4,444 kg of seed. The 200L container treats 8,888 kg of seed. The 1000L container treats 44,444 kg of seed).

METHOD OF APPLICATION:

FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT treated seed should not require drying after trea timent and can be stored or bagged immediately. Add **FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT** to the seed slowly and mix well for at least 3-5 minutes in treating equipment. Thorough seed coverage is required.

STORAGE CONDITIONS:

Protect from frost.

DISPOSAL (FOR RETURNABLE/REFILLABLE CONTAINERS):

- 1. After use, return the container to the point of purchase or designated locations.
- 2. This container must only be refilled with FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT. Do not reuse container for any other purpose.
- 3. Prior to refilling inspect thoroughly for damage such as cracks, punctures, abrasions, and damaged or worn out threads on closure devices.
- 4. Check for leaks after refilling and before transportation. Do not refill or transport damaged or leaking containers.
- 5. If the container is not being refilled, return to point of purchase.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes : Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing : take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre ordoctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled : move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

Do not use treated seed for feed, food or oil processing.

Do not store FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT near feed or foodstuffs.

Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

Do not contaminate domestic or irrigation waters.

Treated seed must be labeled as follows:

"This seed has been treated with **FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT** containing iprodione and thiram. Do not use for feed, food or oil processing". The date of treatment must also be included.

Do not store treated seed for more than 6 months. Treated seed stored for periods in excess of 6 months may decrease in germination at a faster rate than untreated seed. Treated seed stored for more than 6 months should be tested for germination before planting.

Thoroughly clean auger after hand ling treated seed before us ing same auger for handling commercial or feedgrains.

Leftover treated seed should not be stored wher e there is a chance of it becoming mixed with untreated seed.

Store treated seed in cool, dry conditions.

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

For resistance m anagement, please note that **FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA an d MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT** contains a Group 2 and a Group M² fungicide. Any fungal population may contain individuals naturally resistant to **FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT** and other Group 2 and or M² fungicides. A gradual or total loss of pest control m ay occur over tim e if these fungicides are used repeatedly in the sam e fields. Other resistance mechanisms that are not linked to site of action but specific for individual chemicals, such as enhanced m etabolism, may also exist. Appropriate resistance-m anagement strategies should be followed.

To delay fungicide resistance:

• Where possible, rotate the use of FOUNDATION LITE CANOLA and MUSTARD SEED TREATMENT or other Group 2 and M² fungicides with different groups that control the

same pathogens. Use tank m ixtures with fungicide from a different group when such use is permitted.

- Fungicide use should be based on an IPM pr ogram that includes scouting, historical information related to pesticide use and crop rotation and considers cultural, biological and other chemical control practices.
- Monitor treated fungal populations for resistan ce development. If disease continues to progress after treatment with this product, do not increase the use rate. Discontinue use of this product, and switch to another fungicide with a different target site of action, if available.
- Contact your local extension specialist or certified crop advisors for any additional pesticide resistance-management and/or IPM recomm endations for specific crops and pathogens.
