DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. To be used to eliminate ticks and mites in the ears of dogs and cats and for the relief from itching.

Apply 5 drops into the ears twice daily until ticks and mites are eliminated. Do not repeat treatment more than twice daily. Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem continues/reoccurs. Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment. Do not use on nursing animals. Do not use on animals under 12 weeks of age. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed. Do NOT administer by mouth. A veterinarian should be consulted when pest infestation continues to be a problem on the pet.

PRECAUTIONS: HUMANS: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, use rubber gloves. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came into contact with the product) with soap and water.
