DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

1. INITIAL DOSAGE for a freshly-filled pool having no visible algae growth: Add 60 to 80 mL of BUSAN 1333 CONTROLS CHLORINE-RESISTANT ALGAE per 10,000L of pool water.
2. INITIAL DOSAGE for a pool having visible algae growth: Add 150 mL of BUSAN 1333 CONTROLS CHLORINE-RESISTANT ALGAE per 10,000 L of pool water. Brush pool surface to remove any clinging dead algae. Vacuum the pool to remove any dead algae which has settled.
3. MAINTENANCE DOSAGE of 30 to 50 mL of BUSAN 1333 CONTROLS CHLORINERESISTANT ALGAE per 10,000 L of pool water is to be added weekly, following initial dosage, to keep pool free of algae growth.

WARNING: Staining of pool surfaces may occur due to the deposit of copper salts in contact with chlorine oxidizer. Excessive levels of copper will increase the probability of this occurrence.

PRECAUTIONS

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Do not mix with any other chemical. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

FIRST AID

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat Symptomatically. Avoid giving alcohol or alcohol related product.
