SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. Retain packaging information for future reference. Wet the dog's/cat's head with water to drive pests onto the body. Hold the can in an upright position from a distance of 20 cm from the dog/cat. Spray the entire body of the dog/cat, beginning at the head and working towards the tail. Ticks are difficult to control and must be sprayed directly.
