SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING - SPRAYS A FINE MIST OR JET STREAM

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Adjust nozzle to provide desired spray pattern and squeeze trigger to operate. Spray to provide thorough coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed. Repeat as needed. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Spray in early morning or in the evening. Do not spray in direct sunlight. Do not use on maiden hair ferns. Use only on plants listed below:

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not allow others such as children and pets on treatment area during application or to re-enter treated areas until spray has dried. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. If used indoors, remove birds and pets from room being sprayed for one hour. This product is toxic to fish. Cover aquariums for one hour. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
