PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

FIRST AID

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

General: Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Remove victim to a safe and uncontaminated area. Seek medical attention immediately if irritation persists or is severe.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

Note to physician: There is no specific antidote. Treatment of overexposure should be directed at the control of symptoms and the clinical condition.
