SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING!

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For outdoor use around homes, cottages and other residential buildings or around farm buildings (e.g. barns, stables). Traps should be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or wildlife. Traps should be placed in areas of high house fly population and should be used as part of a house fly control strategy. When used in areas accessible to birds, bait must be placed in a bait station that prevents birds from consuming the bait.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

General:

Treated baits must be placed in locations NOT accessible to children, pets, livestock or wildlife.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

- I. For use with Fly Terminator, Fly Terminator Pro and Magnum Fly Traps
- 1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING (Attractant may settle during storage.)
- 2. Hold attractant with tip at top, carefully twist off tip and squirt attractant into empty trap jug. DO NOT SQUEEZE TUBE WHILE TWISTING OFF THE TOP.
- 3. Pour 30 mL of attractant concentrate into Fly Terminator Fly Trap or Fly Terminator Pro Fly Trap; or 60 mL of attractant concentrate into Magnum Fly Trap.
- 4. Fill Fly Trap one-third to one-half full with clean water.
- 5. Place trap on the ground in a sunlit area of high house fly concentration. Traps may also be hung from the handle or from the tab on top of jug.
- II. For use with Milk Jugg Trap
- 1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING (Attractant may settle during storage.)
- 2. Rinse out a standard 4 litre (one-gallon) milk or water jug. Use only transparent type jugs, not opaque or coloured.
- 3. NOTE: Attractant has a pungent odor; bait trap outdoors. Hold attractant with tip at top, carefully twist off tip and squirt attractant into empty trap jug. DO NOT SQUEEZE TUBE WHILE TWISTING OFF THE TOP.
- 4. Fill the jug half full with clean water, and swirl jug slightly to disperse attractant.
- 5. Slide cylinder part of trap head into mouth of jug.
- 6. Place trap on ground or hang by jug handle outdoors in a sunlit area of high house fly concentration when flies are active and wherever odours will not be a problem. For maximum effectiveness, trap should be within 1.21m (4 feet) of the ground.

MAINTENANCE: Trap contents should be agitated at least twice weekly to thoroughly wet all trapped flies. Add water to the trap jug as necessary to keep the jug half full of liquid. Do not allow trap to dry out. Remove trap when it is 1/3 or more full of flies. Trap head may be reused; bait new jug with one 30 ml tube or two 15 ml tubes of Starbar Fly Terminator and Magnum Attractant, or one ounce (two tablespoons) of Starbar Fly Terminator® and Magnum® Attractant and fill the jug half full of water.

HELPFUL HINTS: In areas of very low fly density, the attractant may dissipate before enough flies are caught. To continue attraction when fewer than 50 or so flies are caught within 5 days of baiting, additional attractant should be added. Occasionally, spiders may set up housekeeping in the top assembly, greatly, reducing the trap's efficiency. If this occurs, remove top assembly and pull out spiders and webbing with a twig. Use several traps in different locations. A good trapping program should supplement proper manure management. Dead flies make an excellent natural fertilizer. Never seal dead flies in a closed container. Doing so may result in a hazardous explosion.

Net Contents: Two 30ml attractant tubes

- III. For use with Trap 'n Toss Disposable Fly Trap
- 1. While tightly pinching base of attractant tube's spout with thumb and forefinger, cut or twist off tip of spout.
- 2. While holding the trap upside down, squeeze entire Attractant tube contents (15 mL tube) into trap and then place empty tube into the trap.
- 3. While still holding the trap upside down, pour in 472 ml (16 fluid ounces) of clean water (Fill to fill line.)

Agitate lightly to disperse Attractant, and then slowly turn the trap right side up.

Place the trap outside, either hanging or on the ground, in a sunlit area of high house fly concentration where flies are active and wherever odors will not be a problem. When placing the trap on the ground, be sure that at least 0.6 cm (1/4 inch) of space is available between the trap body and the ground to permit flies to enter trap. If the trap must be placed on soft or sandy ground, place the trap on a piece of paper or cardboard to keep it from sinking in and hindering fly access.

Net contents: One 15 ml tube

IV. For use with Fly Relief Fly Trap and Giant Fly Relief Fly Trap

- 1. Pull up trap top by tab until snapped into position.
- 2. Hang the trap outside in a sunlit area of high fly concentration where flies are active and where odors will not be a problem. For maximum effectiveness, trap should be within 1.21m (4 feet) of the ground.
- 3. The Attractant tube is inside trap bag and must not be removed. Hold base of Attractant tube (within bag) tightly with thumb and forefinger, pointing tube downward. Twist tip of spout until it snaps, allowing Attractant to pour out into bag. NOTE: Hold trap upright so Attractant does not spill out of top. You may need to squeeze Attractant tube to force liquid out.
- 4. Fill trap to "fill line" by pouring clean water through top of trap. NOTE: For best results, fill the trap while it is hanging.
- 5. Agitate lightly to disperse attractant.

MAINTENANCE: Trap contents should be agitated at least twice weekly to thoroughly wet all trapped flies. Add water as necessary to keep the fluid level 1 cm (1/2 inch) below the surface of trapped flies. Do not allow the trap to dry out. Without adequate agitation, fly larvae (maggots) may appear as a layer of dry dead flies accumulates in the trap. If this should occur, add one teaspoon of liquid dish soap and enough water to wet all flies thoroughly. Maggots will drown in soapy water. Dead flies in trap may give

off bad odour so care should be taken to keep trap contents from coming in contact with hands or clothing.

HELPFUL HINTS: In areas having exceptionally hard water, using distilled or purified water may improve trap performance. In areas of heavy fly populations, use several traps in different locations.

Net contents: 30ml tube

- V. For use with Captivator Fly Trap
- 1. For Captivator Fly Trap and other 2-litre (half-gallon) traps: Squeeze one tube (15mL) Attractant into the trap jar.
- 2. Fill trap one-third to one-half full with clean water and set or hang trap outdoors in sunlit area of high house fly density.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, PETS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND WILDLIFE. Keep away from feed or foodstuffs. Wear chemical resistant gloves during application. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
