## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

Detailed information on chemical and physical properties and other formulating recommendations for EVEREST Technical Herbicide are available from UPL AgroSolutions Canada Inc. Obtain and read this information before use to avoid formulation hazards and ensure a satisfactory finished product.

## **PRECAUTIONS**

- **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.**
- Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing.
- Do not breathe dust or vapor.
- Wear a NIOSH-approved respirator, protective clothing, and chemical-resistant gloves when handling.
- Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE (Personal Protective Equipment). If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep PPE apart from other laundry and wash separately.
- Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside, then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.

## **FIRST AID**

- If swallowed:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
- If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.
- If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

### **TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION**

No specific antidote is available. Treat symptomatically.

### **ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS**

TOXIC to aquatic organisms.

### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

#### **STORAGE**

Store in cool, dry place and in such a manner as to prevent cross contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, or feed. Store in original container and out of reach of children, preferably in a locked storage area. EVEREST Technical Herbicide is not affected by freezing.

#### **DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.

**Spill Clean-up:** Handle and open container carefully to prevent spillage. If the container is leaking or product is spilled, carefully sweep product into a pile and shovel into a tightly closable container, then dispose of as directed above.
