SERGEANT'S FLEA & TICK MOUSSE FOR DOGS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use ONLY in well-ventilated area, preferably outdoors. Shake well before using. Hold can about 2 cm above pet's back and spray the foam from the dog's head to tail. Do not spray face, eyes or genitals. Rub the foam thoroughly into the pet's coat in an amount which moistens, but does not soak the entire haircoat. Do not use on dogs under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing dogs or dogs receiving drug or other pesticide treatment. Do not use this mousse more often than once a week. Treatment must only be repeated if pest problem persists or reoccurs.

For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the dog should be combined with sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the dog's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas. If pest problems persist, an insecticidal premise treatment may be required. A veterinarian should be consulted when pest infestation continues to be a problem on the dog.

PRECAUTIONS:

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do NOT puncture or incinerate container even when empty. Do NOT store at temperatures over 50°C. Keep away from open flames or sparks.

HUMANS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with mouth, eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid contact with pet until dry. Avoid skin contact by wearing rubber gloves. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came into contact with the product) with soap and water. Avoid product contact with food, food utensils or places where food is prepared or stored.

PETS: Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May irritate eyes, nose and throat. Avoid direct spray of dog's mouth, face, eyes and genitals. Discontinue use if dermal or nasal irritation develops. Toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Cover fish aquaria in the vicinity of treatment areas. Toxic to birds.

FIRST AID: HUMANS: IF INHALED, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. **IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **IF IN EYES,** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED,** call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

PETS: Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Take container, label, or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical or veterinary attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, wrap then dispose of in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
