GENERAL INFORMATION

Denatonium benzoate, an extremely bitter lignocaine derivative has been used worldwide for deterring ingestion of toxic products for many years. In humans, it can be detected as a slightly bitter taste at 30ppb, and at 10-20ppm imparts an extremely unpleasant bitter taste.
