

To be used only in the manufacture of insecticides which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act. MULTICIDE[®] Intermediate 2086 is designed for use at the rate of 2.25% (wt.) with appropriate carriers and propellents in the preparation of water-based insecticide sprays.

Do not use in food handling, storage or preparation areas while food is present.

PRECAUTIONS:
