LATER'S GRASS & WEED KILLER SUPER CONCENTRATE

DIRECTIONS: Later's Grass & Weed Killer Super Concentrate is a non-selective herbicide. It controls most annual and perennial grasses, including lawn grasses and quackgrass, broadleaf weeds, and brush, (i.e. virtually anything that is green and growing). It is absorbed by the leaves and moves throughout stem and roots to control the entire plant. Mature perennial weeds should be treated after seed heads, flowers or fruit appear. All plants are most easily controlled in the young, actively growing, seedling stage.

Later's Grass & Weed Killer Super Concentrate wilts and browns plants within 48 hours. Plants usually dry up within 7 days. There is no soil activity and this weed killer will not no run off to affect nearby vegetation. To ensure that this product gets down to the roots, avoid tillage or disturbing the treated area for 7 - 10 days after treatment or as directed below. Make sure to contact only those plants that you want to kill as the spray will damage or kill any desirable plants it contacts. Do not spray in windy conditions. Heavy rainfall immediately after application may wash the chemical off the foliage and repeat treatment may be required. Do not apply if rainfall is forecast. Use a repeat application on any seedlings that re-grow from seeds. Glyphosate is not to be applied using hand-wicking or hand-daubing methods,

HOW TO USE: Mix 20 mL of this product in 1 L of clean water and apply over 20 m² (5 paces by 4 paces) of area. Apply to wet the leaves and stems but not to the point of runoff.

Undesirable vegetation control on driveways, hard to mow areas and for lawn trimming/edging and patio weed control: Apply to vigorously growing plants. Apply to annual weeds anytime after emergence. Mature perennial weeds should be treated after seed heads, flowers or fruit appear.

Weed control around trees/shrubs/Ornamentals: When spraying around trees take care not to contact leaves, stems or green bark of desirable plants.

Lawn/Garden Renovation: In lawns, apply only to the area where control is desired. Drift or application to desirable plants or grasses around the target area will be killed. Allow at least 3 days before disturbing the soil and/or replanting to ensure time for the product to penetrate and kill the roots.

Brush control: Apply when leaves are fully expanded. Cut back growth to 1.5 m before treatment.
