Do not pre-dissolve this product before applying through skimmer. Do not mix this product with any other product or chemicals. Always run pump for 2-4 hours after application.

- 1. Maintain recommended daily levels as determined by a testing kit:

 Free available chlorine: 1.0-3.0 ppm
 PH: 7.2-7.8

 Total Alkalinity: 100-120 ppm
 Calcium Hardness 200-300 ppm
- 2. For outdoor pools, chlorine residuals can be protected from destruction by the sun's rays by adding 300 grams of stabilizer (cyanuric acid) per 10,000 L of pool water to yield the required initial concentration of 30 ppm.
- 3. Initially, chlorinate pool water with 120 g of **Guardex**® **Advantage Chlor**TM per, 10,000 L of pool water. After 2 hours, test chlorine level (residual). Repeat dosage until you obtain a chlorine level of 1.0 3.0 ppm.
