DIRECTIONS: Apply when insects or their damage appear.

LAWN INSECTS: Ants: Spot treat as necessary. Sprinkle over and around ant hills and along trails, applying 250 g per 10 m². Do not water for two days. Repeat in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary. **Armyworms, Chinch bugs, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Mosquitoes, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moths) and others:** Mow lawn and apply 500 g per 20 m². Apply a thin uniform coating of dust to both the upper and lower surfaces of grass blades when the air is still, preferably in early morning or evening. Do not water for two days. Repeat in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Hazardous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly after use. Do not contaminate feed, food, ponds or streams. Very poisonous to bees. Avoid application on flower and fruit blossoms.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If on skin or clothing,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If swallowed,** call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If inhaled,** move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap empty container and discard in household garbage.
