NOTICE TO USER

This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label. It is an offence under the *Pest Control Products Act* to use this product in a way that is inconsistent with the directions on the label. FIRST AID

IN CASE OF POISONING, contact a physician or a poison control centre **IMMEDIATELY**. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor **IMMEDIATELY** for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin **IMMEDIATELY** with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

There is no specific antidote for this product. If large amount has been ingested and emesis is inadequate, lavage stomach. Treat symptomatically.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Strictly observe all precautions for handling and using pesticides. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wear protective goggles when handling. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. May irritate eyes. Do not wear contact lenses while handling. Use of an approved pesticide respirator is recommended. Wear coveralls or long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical resistant gloves, boots and goggles when handling. Wash gloves thoroughly with soap and water before removing them during, or following, any operation. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling product and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, smoking or using the toilet. Do not eat, drink or smoke during handling. Remove contaminated clothing immediately after use. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling contaminated clothing.

STORAGE

Store product in the original container. Keep out of the reach of children and animals. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage. If freezing occurs, place the container in a warm room (18°C or above) and allow product to thaw. Roll or shake container frequently until thawing is complete.
