Hartz Ref. 114 contains an insect growth regulator (IGR), vIGRen (Precor), to kill flea eggs before they hatch. Adult fleas spend virtually all of their time on the pet and produce vast numbers of eggs which drop off the pet and develop in the environment. Once fleas are apparent on your pet, there is already an infestation of their pre-adult stages in your home. Traditional insecticides kill only the adult fleas, not their eggs. However, Hartz Ref 114 is designed to kill flea eggs, thereby breaking the flea life cycle.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: This product is packaged in single dosage tubes. This package contains three (six) monthly 1 mL dosages .

Do not use this product more often than once every 3 weeks. Treat your cat or kitten monthly for continual pest control in situations where there is an ongoing risk of pest infestation. Do NOT administer by mouth. Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment. Do not use on animals under 8 weeks of age. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed. If condition persists, consult your veterinarian. RETAIN PACKAGING INFORMATION FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet should be combined with the sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets, furniture, etc. (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters, and surrounding areas. If pest problems persists, an insecticidal premise treatment (e.g. Hartz Control Pet Care System Home Flea & Tick Killer) may be required. A veterinarian should be consulted when pest infestation continues to be a problem on the pet.

Remove one applicator tube from package and hold in an upright position. Hold bottom of tube with one hand. With the other hand, snap cap off. Position the tip of the tube on the cat's back between the shoulder blades and squeeze out entire contents of the tube. Repeat every month, if flea problem persists.

After application, through its natural movement, your pet's skin and hair oils carry Hartz Ref. 114 over the pet's body for protection against flea infestations.

PRECAUTIONS:

<u>HUMANS:</u> KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with mouth, eyes and clothing. Use rubber gloves when applying product. Avoid contact with pet until dry. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came into contact with the product) with soap and water. Avoid product contact with food, food utensils or places where food is prepared or stored.

<u>PETS:</u> Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with the cat's mouth, face, eyes and genitals.Care should be taken to prevent exposure of other pets who may be in close physical contact with the treated animal. Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide for pets. Smaller animals are more likely to experience an adverse reaction. Observe carefully.

FIRST AID:

HUMANS: IF SWALLOWED, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

PETS: If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your

pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

Take container, label, or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical or veterinary attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically. No specific antidote.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry place away from food and out of the reach of children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and discard with household garbage.
