PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Harmful if swallowed. May cause eye or skin irritation. Wash well after handling and before eating, drinking and smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Do not wear contaminated shoes.

FIRST AID:

Eye Contact: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Skin or Clothing Contact: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Ingestion: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Inhalation: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Refer to the label. No specific antidote. Treat symptomatically.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS: TOXIC to aquatic organisms and terrestrial plants. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, irrigation water, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

STORAGE: Keep in original container during storage. Store product in cool, dry, well ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer, or other pesticides.

SPILLAGE CLEAN-UP: Keep by-standers away. Do not smoke, drink or eat during clean-up operations. Wear protective equipment (respirator, coveralls, rubber boots and protective gloves) and sweep up all product and shovel into a drum. Cover remaining spill with absorbent material and sweep into drum. Add broken packages to the drum and seal for removal to an approved disposal site. Wash spill site with water and mop up into a drum for disposal to an approved disposal site. Do not breathe vapours. Remove and wash all protective clothing and equipment. Shower and wash thoroughly with soap and water on completion of mopping up operation. For details on spill cleaning contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL: Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations.
