**DISPOSAL:**

Canadian formulators of this product should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal and provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer

**STORAGE:** Store in dry well ventilated place no lower in temperature than 10 deg C or higher than 50 deg C.

**PRECAUTIONS: DANGER - CORROSIVE- KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.** Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear glasses or face shield and chemical resistant gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not contaminate food. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters.

**FIRST-AID:**

**If in Eyes:** hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If on Skin or Clothing:** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If Swallowed:** call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If Inhaled:** move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measure against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Avoid alcohol
