**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the **PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT**.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

**PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.** Dangerous gas formed when mixed with acid. Do not mix with any other chemical. Strong oxidizing agent. If inhaled, Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
