TREATMENT

NUOSEPT 515R® PRESERVATIVE is recommended for the control of bacteria in polymer lattices including acrylic, styrene/butadiene, carboxylates of styrene/butadiene, ethylene/vinyl acetate and polyvinyl acetate and starch-based emulsions.

ADHESIVES AND PAINTS

Add 430 grams to 3.3 kg. to each 1,000 kg of emulsion to provide 425 to 3350 ppm product (6.25 to 50 ppm active isothiazolones).
