DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Initial dosa ge for po ol water havin g no visible algae i s 400 mL of MAÎTRE PISCINIER PISCIALG 5 LIQUID ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 2. Weekly main tenance do sage is 200 mL of MAÎTRE PISCINIER PISCIALG 5 LIQUI D ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 3. For pool water havin g visible alg ae, su perchlorinate following I abel instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before a dding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible al gae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 1 L of MAÎT RE PISCINIER PISCIALG 5 LIQUID ALGAECIDE per 10,000 L of pool water.

DO NOT apply when swimmers are in the immediate vicinity (a 15 minute restricted-entry interval is recommended).

PRECAUTIONS

Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give arti ficial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison con-
