DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used in the manufacture of products registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Store the container tightly closed away from seeds, fertilizer, plants and foodstuffs. Wash concentrate from skin or eyes immediately. Avoid working in spray mist. After use, wash hands and other exposed skin.
