#### PRECAUTIONS

### FIRST AID

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Oilfield Applications:

Use at 100 ppm active ingredient based on water content of oil and gas field water systems until bacterial control is achieved. Inject at a point that will ensure uniform mixing.

Maintenance dosage: 10-25 ppm.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE**: Store away from oxidizing materials, heat and sources of ignition, and food and food containers. Avoid contact with metals.
