## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

## PRECAUTIONS

1. **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.**
2. **DO NOT** take internally. Harmful if swallowed.
3. **DO NOT** get in eyes or on skin. Causes eye and skin irritation. Avoid inhalation of vapour or spray.
4. Wash exposed areas of skin thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking or going to the washroom. Take a shower immediately after work.
5. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants and chemical resistant gloves and goggles or face shield during mixing, loading, clean up and repair.
6. If clothing becomes contaminated, remove immediately and wash. Store and wash all protective clothing separately from household laundry. Wash in detergent and hot water before reuse. Wear freshly laundered clothes daily.
7. **DO NOT** contaminate domestic or irrigation water, lakes, streams or ponds by the cleaning of equipment or the disposal of wastes.
8. This product contains a petroleum distillate which is moderately to highly toxic to aquatic organisms. Avoid contamination of aquatic systems. **DO NOT** contaminate these systems through direct application, disposal of wastes or cleaning equipment.

## FIRST AID

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

## **TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION**

Contains petroleum distillates greater than 10%. **DO NOT** induce vomiting. Treat symptomatically.

## **STORAGE**

1. Store the product in original, tightly-closed container and do not allow water to be introduced into this container.
2. **DO NOT** ship or store the product near food, feed, seed or fertilizers.
3. Store the product in a cool, dry, locked, well-ventilated area without floor drain.
4. Herbicides should be shipped or stored separately from other pesticides to avoid cross-contamination.
