**DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. PROTECT FROM FREEZING.** Apply GRUBOUT<sup>®</sup> when insects or their damage appear. Mix only as much spray solution as required on day of mixing. Agitate mixture before and during use.

**5 mL = 1 teaspoonful**

**15 mL = 1 tablespoonful**

**For control of White Grubs (European Chafer and suppression of Japanese Beetle):** Apply 42 to 58 mL of GrubOut<sup>®</sup> in 15-20 L of water per 10 m<sup>2</sup> of established lawn. Remove excessive thatch and water before treatment if soil is dry. Repeat as necessary. To optimize control of European Chafer and Japanese Beetle apply GrubOut<sup>®</sup> in late July / early August.

**For control of Ants, Chinch Bugs, Climbing Cutworms, Earwigs, Fall Armyworm, Fleas, Leafhoppers, Millipedes, Mosquitoes and Sod Webworms:** Apply 37.5 to 52 mL of GrubOut<sup>®</sup> in 15-20 L of water per 10 m<sup>2</sup> of established lawn, recreational area, roadway or path borders. For best results mow lawn and apply after watering or rain. Ensure good penetration of turf. Hose-end or pressure applications may be used. Repeat 2 to 3 weeks later if necessary.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store unused Wilson<sup>®</sup> SEVIN<sup>®</sup> GrubOut<sup>®</sup> Ant & Grub Killer Concentrate<sub>(1)</sub> in original container only, in cool, dry area out of reach of children and animals. Do not store in areas where temperature frequently exceeds 38° C. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty pesticide containers. Wrap empty containers in newspaper and dispose of with household garbage.
