

**TIPS:** Before wasps become a problem, inspect your yard and home surroundings in early summer, looking for any wasp activity or paper nests taking shape. Avoid leaving food or drink uncovered when eating outside. Keep all garbage covered in tightly closed containers until it can be thrown out. Spraying after nightfall is recommended because wasps are less active at night.

**Use THIS product to: Kill (bugs) at the source:** Use (Raid® Wasp & Hornet Killer 7) (this product) (outdoors) to kill wasps, hornets, and their entire nests on contact. (Gives) (rapid contact kill of wasps and hornets returning to the treated nest.) (Sprays up to 5.7 m.) (For control of nests of wasps, yellowjackets and Hornets.) (Any insects returning to the nest after treatment will be killed.)

**Use OTHER Raid products to: Kill (bugs) on Contact:** Use Raid® Mosquito & Fly Killer 1 (indoors) to kill individual wasps (and other listed insects) on contact.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE: FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY.** For control of nests of Wasps, Yellowjackets and Hornets. Shake can well before using. Hold can upright before spraying. Use only for spot applications. A spot treatment is made to a localized surface area not greater than 0.2 m<sup>2</sup>. Spots are not to be adjoining and the total area of spots is not to exceed 10% of the surface area being treated. The best time to spray the nest is in the early morning or early evening, when air temperature is cooler and most insects are in the nest and little activity is observed around the nest opening. Spray only if the

air is still. Stand at a safe distance from the nest, not directly under it. Hold container upright at arms length, point the actuator at the nest and spray into the opening of the nest.. Treated insects may fall out of the nest and die. Any insects returning to the nest after treatment will be killed. Spray stray insects directly. After 48 hours, wear gloves to remove any treated nests. Foliage of desirable plants that were contacted with spray should be hosed off.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Causes moderate eye irritation. May irritate skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after use. Do not apply directly to humans, pets, plants, or contaminate food, food containers, utensils or food preparation areas. Toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not apply directly to water. Toxic to bees. Do not spray bees. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not puncture or incinerate container or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not apply this product around equipment due to possibility of shock hazard. This product may stain or adversely affect vinyl, painted, and plastic surfaces. Avoid application to asphalt roofing shingles as staining may occur. Before using in areas where spray may contact these surfaces, test in an inconspicuous area and recheck in a few hours.

**FIRST AID:** **If on skin or clothing**, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If in eyes**, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If swallowed**, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If inhaled**, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Contains petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Treat symptomatically.

**DISPOSAL:** When container is empty, press the valve to release all remaining pressure. Dispose of container in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.

This container may be recycled in communities where (steel) aerosol can recycling is available. Before offering for recycling, empty the can by following the procedure described above.
