DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For outdoor use only.

Plantskydd Deer Repellent Soluble Powder prevents browsing damage by deer and elk on conifers for 2-4 months. May also repel deer and elk from all other outdoor ornamental plants (e.g., deciduous trees, deciduous shrubs, and flowers). Plantskydd Deer Repellent Soluble Powder may also repel rabbits and hares from browsing outdoor ornamental plants (e.g., trees, shrubs and flowers).

It is advisable to treat a small portion of plant(s) to determine sensitivity. Plants treated with Plantskydd Deer Repellent Soluble Powder may experience some side effects such as becoming darker in appearance or leaf curl. Original color returns after 1 or 2 days. Avoid spraying blossoms. Avoid spraying surface of other substrates such as concrete and wood to prevent damage such as discolouration.

Expect some reduction in repellency during very warm and sunny weather (e.g., June-August).

DO NOT apply to any body of water.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Mixing Instructions:

DO NOT apply undiluted. Dilute Plantskydd Deer Repellent Soluble Powder prior to spraying plants as follows:

| Pest | Plants | Dilution Rate |

| Deer and Elk | Conifers and Dormant Deciduous Woody Ornamentals | 200 grams of Plantskydd Deer Repellent Soluble Powder in 1 L of water |

| Rabbits and Hares | Ornamental Plants | 86 grams of Plantskydd Deer Repellent Soluble Powder in 1 L of water |

1. Pour water into mixing container.
2. While stirring water, slowly sprinkle in the soluble powder. In the event of foaming, allow the solution to rest for 10-20 minutes; then stir again.
3. After mixing, allow the mixture to stand for a minimum of 20 minutes.
4. Once mixed, pour solution through the strainer (provided) into pressure type, hand or backpack sprayer.

NOTE: Use mixed solution within a few days. Protect from heat.

Note: If sprayer clogs, flush with hot water.

Apply when temperatures are above 0°C.

Plants should be well hydrated prior to treatment. Apply to dry plants only.

After rainfall or watering, wait until plants are dry. Adjust sprayer nozzle for fine spray.. After spraying, allow to dry for 1 to 2 days before watering.

Apply to the parts of the plants which are frequently browsed. For deer and elk, spray the top of the plant. For rabbits and hares, spray the stems and lower leaves.

Conifer seedlings: For use on cedar, fir, pine, spruce and other conifer seedlings. Apply before browsing begins in late fall (overwinter browse) or early spring. Treat pine before or after, but not during, bud-flush period. DO NOT exceed two spray blasts per plant. Spray once or twice per year as browsing conditions warrant.

All other outdoor ornamentals (e.g., trees, shrubs, flowers): Apply before browsing begins (e.g., early spring). Spray plants until thoroughly wet but not to dripping. Always apply to new growth. Re-apply as necessary if browsing damage persists and after periods of significant new plant growth. Note: Treat pine before or after, but not during, bud-flush period.

IMPORTANT:

Rinse mixing container and sprayer when empty.

Rinse any equipment such as bags, gloves, raingear etc., after each day's use.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

DO NOT ingest powder or liquid solution. Wash hands with soap and water after handling.

For good hygiene practice, wear waterproof gloves when handling this product.

FIRST AID:

If on skin or clothing : Take off contaminated clothing, flush the skin with water for 15 to 20 minutes.

Call a poison control center or doctor for advice on treatment.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for

15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE:

- Store this product away from food or feed.
- Do not store as liquid suspension.
- Store in a cool, dry, dark place between 5° and 20° C for up to 90 days after opening.
- Avoid direct sunlight and freezing

DISPOSAL:

Do not re-use empty container. Wrap and dispose of empty container with household garbage.

Unused or partially used products should be disposed at provincially or municipally designated hazardous waste disposal sites.
