DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SURFACE MOLD INHIBITION IN WET LAP AND SHEET PULP

Depending on the level of contamination, add 0.4 mL to 1.0 mL of Spectrum PR1912 per litre of treatment solution (400 ppm to 1000 ppm). The treatment solution must be applied on dewatered pulp surfaces at a ratio of one litre of solution per 8.33 square meters of surface to be treated. Application should be done using applicator rolls, shower or sprayer. The length of the expected protection period against growth of surface mold on wet lap and sheet pulp is 30 days.

Spectrum PR1912 is for the protection of wet lap and sheet pulp, (not to be used on wet lap or sheet pulp that will be used in the manufacture of paper or paperboard that will come in contact with food or potted plants) and is NOT for the protection of users and others against mold, bacteria, viruses, germs or other disease-causing organisms.
