DIRECTIONS FOR USE: General. Shake before use. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts. Use Blaze Crawling Insect Bug Killer as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localised areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

For spot treatment. To kill ants, cockroaches, crickets, silverfish, spiders, sowbugs, earwigs, and carpet beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To kill brown dog ticks and fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localised areas of floor and floor coverings where

these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Treat Pets With This Product. For effective flea and tick control, pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product designed for use on pets (N.B. this product is not for use on pets), and treatment of the pet must be combined with the cleanup and sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets, and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters, and surrounding areas prior to treatment with this product.

Flies and mosquitoes: Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localised resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

For crack and crevice. To kill ants, cockroaches, crickets, silverfish, sow bugs, spiders, earwigs, brown dog ticks, fleas, and carpet beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin or clothing. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Do not use on humans, plants, animals, foodstuff, food utensils, fishbowls or animal feed areas. Do not use as a space spray. Do not use in any area where food is handled, prepared or stored. May cause skin and/or eye irritation. Product is very toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by improper use or disposal. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stove or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50 degrees C.

FIRST AID: If swallowed. Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention. Contains volatile petroleum distillate.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: This product contains petroleum distillates. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Treat symptomatically.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all remaining pressure. Wrap and discard empty container in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
